



Tips to Preparing for Incredible Years (IY) Consultation Days (Teachers involved with the Teacher Classroom Management workshops)

A consultation workshop is a chance for teachers to meet together with other teachers and an accredited IY coach, mentor or trainer to share their experiences using behavior management strategies. They will do this by showing videos of their teaching, for peer feedback and support. This process helps teachers to continue to improve their skills and become the best teachers possible. Below are some guidelines to help you prepare for a teacher consultation day.

At the consultation workshops, please be prepared to:

- Bring a DVD cued up to show something you think went well and/or something you want some help with. Usually 10 minutes of tape is enough.
- Think about 3 of your most difficult teaching challenges and 3 of your successes.
- Talk about engagement strategies that you have used to engage parents in their children's learning.
- Share some strategies for how you have worked with other teachers to build a support team.
