

Social Competence Scale-Parent (P-COMP)

Computing P-COMP Subscales and Total Scale

Items were coded on a scale of 0 to 4 (0=not at all, 1=a little, 2=moderately well, 3=well, 4=very well).

Scales were computed as the sum of the component items; the range of possible values for the 2 subscales is 0-24, and 0-48 for the total scale

Items in P-COMP Subscales and Total Scale

Prosocial

1. PSCS4 works out problems own
2. PSCS7 good underst feelings
3. PSCS9 shares things others
4. PSCS10 helpful others
5. PSCS11 listens others viewpoints
6. PSCS12 give opinions not bossy

Emotional Regulation

1. PSCS1 accept not going way
2. PSCS2 copes well failure
3. PSCS3 thinks before acting
4. PSCS5 calm down by self
5. PSCS6 does what told
6. PSCS8 controls temper disagree

Total Social Competence

All 12 of the above items

P-COMP Total Social Competence Scale Cutoffs

Clinical range = <17

Borderline range = 17-20

Normal range = >20
